The sponsor assists your child in preparing for Confirmation through following the "Take 5" study sheet (also included in packet)

Sponsors are welcome to participate with the student they mentor in a variety of activities, service projects, prayer time, and small group instruction. We offer Essential 3 training and Sponsor - Student education to help both build their relationship in the two year process.

At the end of the two year preparation, the student and sponsor will have a strong spiritual relationship that will carry on into the future.
